The feature is a one room prairie school on a foundation of concrete blocks. The gable roofs is covered with asphalt shingles. There is a cement block chimney at the peak at the south end of the roof and a bell tower at the north. The bell tower has a wood base and is leaning to the north as the supports are beginning to give way. The peak roof of the tower has wood shakes with metal capping and finials. There is a bell inside the tower. The soffits are closed. The building measures 18 feet east to west and 24 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits at the peak ends. The remaining siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. There are three double hung, two over two, windows on the east side and two similar windows on the wouth side, some glass and most of the farming. One window is covered. The approach to the school is across a concrete pad to an open area where the entry used to be. The entry is lying in a heap south of the school. There is a wood door. The interior walls of the school are covered with wall board and there is wallboard. The ceiling is covered with wallboard panels. Blackboards have been removed. The flooring is tongue and groove pine. There is a blackboard on the west wall and also on the east half of the north wall. Switches and light fixtures suggest electricity.
