1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a newer constructed one room prairie school on a foundation of concrete blocks. This building was moved to the Frontier Village at the Frontier Museum in Williston. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles with metal capping and finials. There is no chimney. The soffits are open. The building measures 24 feet north to south and 18 feet east to west with an entry that measures 12 feet by 9 feet.

A frieze board can be see under the eaves of all the peaks. The siding is 4 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. An overhang protects the south facing solid core door. An eaves trough as at the outer edge of this part of the roof. There is one new large window, the window has a large pane of glass on the top and two small sliding windows on the bottom, on the east side of the entry. The entry can be reached by either steps off the south of the porch or by a ramp leading up along the east wall. The entry and large room are covered with vinyl. The walls and ceiling are covered with wallboard. A picture rail is on the wall in the main room. There are two more windows with a large piece of glass at the top and two smaller windows at the bottom one of which is a slider. This building has lots of museum storage.


