## 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a foundation of concrete blocks. This school was moved into the farm yard for use as a shop. The gable roof is covered with wood shakes with metal capping. There is a red brick chimney at the peak near the west end. The building measures 20 feet east and west by 16 north and south. The soffits are closed.

The siding begins with a rake board under the eaves at the peak ends of the school. The remaining siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. There are three windows on the north side and two on the south, all covered. A 5 panel wood walkin door was added on the south side after removing one of the windows. Side sliding doors were added to the east end for access by way of a concrete slab. This building was used as a shop and it is stuffed full today. The floor is hard wood. There is a blackboard on the west wall. Walls and ceiling are finished with lathe and plaster. The school was built in 1907 and moved to the current location in the early 1940's.

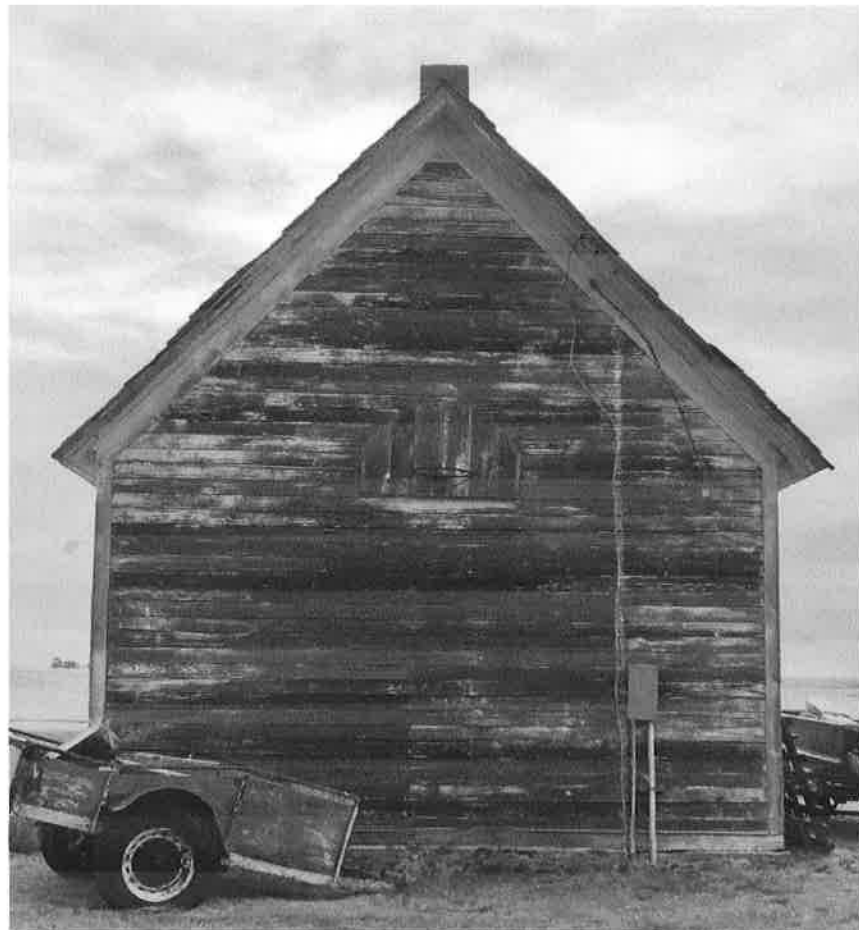

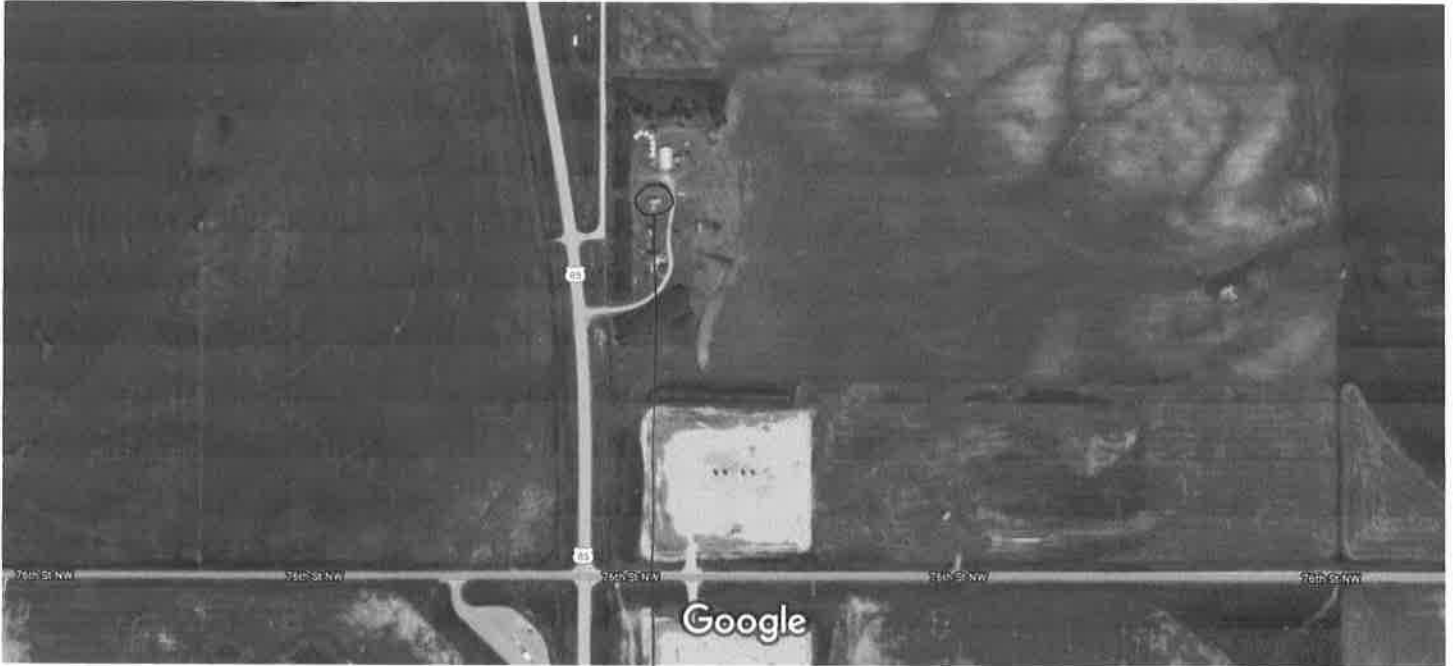
