## 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete and brick basement. The gable roof of the school and entry and hip roof of the bathroom addition are all partially covered with wood shakes with some metal capping and finials. The soffits are closed. There are cornice returns at all the gable ends. The chimney is gone. The school measures 30 feet south to north and 24 feet east to west with the entry measuring 10 feet by 12 feet and the bathroom 4 feet by 12 feet.

A rake board begins the siding under the eaves on all sides of the school. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim with waterboard at the bottom. There is an entry on the west side with double doors. The porch is gone. The exterior doors are three panel wood with window openings on each. There are two window openings in the entry, one faces west and the other north. Inside the entry the walls have wainscot and two more 5 panel wood doors leading into the school room. Two small double hung window openings are located on the north wall of the bathroom. Two large double hung 4 over 4 windows are in the school at either side of the bathroom. Similar windows are on the east side, they are grouped with three together either side of two in the middle. Little glass remains. A halfmoon window sits high on the south wall. The basement wall on the east side has fallen in. There are basement windows on the north, south and west sides. The walls are finished with wallboard. The ceiling was finished with rectangular tiles and many have fallen away. Large white globe lights in the school room indicate the presence of electricity. There are blackboards on the west and south walls of the school room. There is wainscot in the school room.
